## **Declaration of conformity ROHS**

---

With this letter we validate the conformity of our products, according to the current ROHS-directives **2015/863/EU (RoHS III)**. The EU directive defines the use of hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment. Accordingly, electrical and electronic equipment, as well as cables and spare parts, may not be placed on the market if the following limits per mass fraction are exceeded:

- Lead (Pb) 0.1%
- Mercury (Hg) 0.1%
- Cadmium (Cd) 0.01%
- Hexavalent chromium (CrVI) 0.1%
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) 0.1%
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) 0.1%
- Di(2-ethylhexyl)phthalate (DEHP) 0.1%
- Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP) 0.1%
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) 0.1%
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) 0.1%

In principle, cable management systems do not fall within the scope of this directive, but may become part of designated electrical and electronic equipment.

Products containing metallic components comply with the current EU RoHS Directive under application of the following exemptions (lead content up to 4%):

Plastic products without metallic components are EU RoHS compliant without exceptions and therefore also compliant with the current China RoHS II.
